Notice to Shareholders in Allianz Emerging Markets Equity Fund (the “EME Fund”), a sub-fund of Allianz International Investment Funds (the “Company”)

As the Authorised Corporate Director (“ACD”) of the Company, we are hereby giving notice of the following change to the EME Fund which will be reflected in an updated prospectus of the Company (the “Prospectus”):

on 22 September 2026, the name of the EME Fund will change from “Allianz Emerging Markets Equity Fund” to “**Allianz Best Styles Emerging Markets Equity Fund**”.

Background related to and reason for the change

Best Styles Global Equity strategies are used in the management of a number of funds in our global range which are managed by our Systematic Equity portfolio management team.

The EME Fund is also managed by this team, using the AllianzGI Best Styles Emerging Markets Equity strategy. We want to make it explicit in the EME Fund’s name and therefore make it clearer to investors that the Fund is managed using this strategy. This change will be reflected in an updated Prospectus dated 22 September 2026, **but will not alter in any way how the EME Fund is managed, or its risk profile**. Accordingly, whilst descriptions of the Best Styles strategy may be used in the marketing of the EME Fund on our website and in other marketing materials, we consider these documents to be distinct from the formal investment parameters governed by the Financial Conduct Authority’s Collective Investment Schemes Sourcebook (“**COLL**”), which we provide in the Prospectus and Key Investor Information Documents (“**KIIDs**”) as regulatory documents of the EME Fund. These are intended to summarise its key, legally binding features, and these will remain unchanged as a result of the EME Fund’s name change.

The change has been classified as Notifiable in accordance with COLL. According to COLL, FCA approval of the change has been given. The Depositary of the Company also approved it in advance of applying for FCA approval.

You are not required to take any action in relation to the change detailed in this notification. However, if there is anything in this document which you do not understand or if you are in doubt as to what action you should take, you should consult your professional financial adviser.
